
Joe has always been a nerd.

He presses play – and something amazing starts to happen...

Fanboy is a love-hate letter to pop culture and nostalgia. Award-winning writer-performer Joe Sellman-Leava (*Fringe First, Labels*) explores our relationship to our past and future selves and asks why his generation is so obsessed with its childhood.

In 1974, the contraceptive pill was made available to single women on the NHS for the first time. What has changed since then and what if child-free/childless women were at the centre of that narrative?

The Baby Question is a theatrical film exploring the narratives of women who are child-free by choice or circumstance, set in the world of a seventies Top of the Pops style chart tv show.

Following his critically acclaimed show *Learning to Fly*, James Rowland is back with another PIECE OF WORK using his captivating mix of storytelling, music, and comedy.

James has been touring his storytelling theatre shows for half his adult life. This year was different. Returning home after his first stint away he received a letter that exploded his life, and the tour became a search: for the person who sent it, for a sense of home, and to maybe save a life. This remarkable road trip follows James' sell-out shows *Learning to Fly* and *The Songs of Friendship Trilogy*, and features his captivating mix of story, comedy, and music.

James explores how the landscapes we exist in physically affect the way we think and feel. How searching for something is an end in itself, regardless of whether the search is successful. It's about our sense of home, and the hope that makes our lives livable.

Catherine Shaw spent the 90s shocking the art world with her provocative performance art. She's always called herself a feminist, but looking back through the lens of #MeToo, she's questioning how much she enabled the culture she now sees being called out. An ambitious Curator approaches her to put together an exhibition of female Artists at a major new gallery; a scandal breaks and unwittingly caught in the centre, she begins to question everything.

When men behave in unacceptable ways, why do we always point to the women close to them and ask why they did nothing?

Can we, and should we, separate the art from the artist? How far do the ripples of consequence spread? And why is it always women who must hold the moral space?

Indestructible takes in uncompromising female Artists, from Lee Miller to the Guerrilla Girls via Sinead O'Connor and Taylor Swift, to ask: why is it still so difficult for female Artists to succeed? And why are women always the Muse, never the Artist?


